<u>Dogwood Elementary Update</u>: Kara Strouse

- -Dogwood Community School Field
 - -Plans to reduce the visually obstructive trees are being reviewed.
 - -New basketball court is being installed.
- -Summer Learning is in session Monday to Friday from 7:45am to 2:45pm. During this time the field is off-limits.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: Heather Ream, Treasurer

Bank Balance is \$4028. The majority of this is grant money that will go towards the neighborhood sign project.

President's Report: Kelley DeLuca, President

- Phase One of the neighborhood sign grant, which was for the larger signs, is complete.
- Phase Two of the neighborhood sign grant, for smaller perimeter signs, is incomplete and requires modification.
 - The City's policy regarding placement of neighborhood signs, which was being written at the same time the grant was being written, makes it too difficult to find suitable locations for the smaller signs. There are only 2 locations available for the signs, and one of these is in close proximity to one of the large entrance signs.
 - The group discussed whether it makes sense to install only 1 or 2 perimeter signs, or if some or all
 of the remaining grant money should be spent on the greatly needed way-finding signs for the
 Dogwood Community Nature Trail.
 - These options will be discussed and voted on when a quorum is found a future meeting.
- A request has been made that meeting Agendas be distributed in advance of the meetings. The group discussed whether or not this is a good idea. Voting on the matter could not take place due to lack of quorum.
- Elections for Vice President and Secretary will be held at the July meeting. Please submit any nominations for those positions between now and the meeting proper.
